Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 130.

This bill increases the maximum annual salary for registers of wills from \$64,000 to \$75,000, beginning with the next term of office.

House Bill 250, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 12, 1998, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 130.

AN ACT concerning

Registers of Wills - Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the maximum salary that the Board of Public Works may set for a register of wills of a county; and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of an incumbent ~~clerk~~ register.
