~~SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal year 1999 and every fiscal year thereafter, the State shall provide \$35 million for public school construction projects in Prince George's County and the Prince George's County government shall provide a minimum of \$22 million for public school construction projects, and such additional funds as may be necessary to match the annual State appropriation for public school construction projects in Prince George's County.~~

~~SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal year 1999, the State shall provide 80 percent of the eligible costs for the first \$20 million in public school construction costs related to neighborhood school projects. Neighborhood school projects shall be identified by the Interagency Committee on Public School Construction and shall include new public schools and additions or improvements to~~
