SECTION 2-4. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Governor provide a maximum of \$210,000 annually in fiscal years 1999 through 2002 for the operating expenses of the Coordination Office established by this Act.

SECTION 5- 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998. It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 2002, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 172.

This bill provides that court files and records pertaining to an arrest warrant shall not be open to public inspection until either the warrant has been served or 90 days have elapsed since the warrant was issued. In addition, court files and records pertaining to an arrest warrant issued pursuant to a grand jury indictment or conspiracy investigation may not be open to public inspection until all arrest warrants for any coconspirators have been served.

House Bill 270, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 12, 1998, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 172.
