

(VI) IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE SITE DEVELOPMENT OR SUBDIVISION OF LAND, THE PREPARATION OF DESIGN OF AND PLANS FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PREPARATION AND DESIGN ARE IN ACCORDANCE WITH DESIGN MANUALS, DETAILS, AND STANDARDS ACCEPTED BY THE STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITY:

1. ROAD AND STREET GRADES;
2. SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROL MEASURES; AND
3. NONPRESSURIZED CLOSED STORM DRAINAGE AND STORMWATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS; AND
4. OPEN CONDUIT STORM DRAINAGE AND STORM WATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS.

(2) "PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE DESIGN OF, PREPARATION OF, OR SPECIFICATIONS FOR:

(I) COMMUNITY WATER OR WASTEWATER TREATMENT COLLECTION OR DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS;

(II) COMMUNITY PUMPING OR LIFT STATIONS; OR

(III) ~~UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY PARAGRAPH (1)(VI) OF THIS SUBSECTION,~~ GEOTECHNICAL OR STRUCTURAL DESIGN COMPONENTS OF SEDIMENT CONTROL OR STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PONDS OR BASINS.

(h) (1) "Practice property line surveying" means to practice land surveying, except for the services excluded under paragraph (2) of this subsection.

(2) "Practice property line surveying" does not include [preparing a plan for:

(i) a storm drainage system;

(ii) drainage for a street or road; or

(iii) a grade design of a street or road] THE PERFORMANCE OF THE SERVICES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (G)(1)(VI) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
