- (2) Failed to give the required or correct information in his application; or
- (3) Committed fraud in making the application or in obtaining the license.
- (b) On cancellation, the licensee immediately shall surrender the canceled license to the Administration.

## 16-206.

- (a) (3) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A PROVISIONAL LICENSE UNDER § 16–213 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (d) (1) After the Administration refuses to issue a license under this section [or after the Administration], determines that a suspension should be imposed under subsection (a)(2) of this section, OR DETERMINES THAT A SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION SHOULD BE IMPOSED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(3) OF THIS SECTION, the Administration immediately shall give written notice to the applicant or licensee, and the applicant or licensee may request a hearing as provided in Title 12, Subtitle 2 of this article.
- (2) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the Administration may suspend or revoke a license under this section only after a hearing under Title 12, Subtitle 2 of this article.
- (3) If the Administration determines that there is a likelihood of substantial and immediate danger and harm to the licensee or others if the license is continued pending a hearing, the Administration:
  - (i) Immediately may suspend the license;
- (ii) Within 7 days of a request for a hearing, shall grant the licensee a hearing as provided in Title 12, Subtitle 2 of this article; and
- (iii) After the hearing, render an immediate decision as to whether or not it should continue the suspension or revoke the license.
- (e) (1) If a licensee fails to appear for a hearing after receiving the written notice under subsection (d)(1) of this section, the Administration may suspend the licensee until the licensee appears for a hearing.
- (2) A rescheduled hearing shall be held within 30 days of the date of the request.

## 16-212.1.

(a) The Administration, in cooperation with the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration, shall establish an alcohol and drug education [course] PROGRAM to educate driver's license applicants who are subject to the provisions of § 16—103.1(10) 16—105(F)(3) of this subtitle] TITLE. THIS PROGRAM TO ALSO SHALL BE INCLUDED AS PART OF THE DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS TITLE.
