- (II) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE SHALL APPOINT TO THE <u>HEARING</u> BOARD ONE INDIVIDUAL FROM THE LIST OF NOMINEES THAT EACH MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL SUBMITS.
- (III) THE COUNTY COUNCIL BY RESOLUTION SHALL CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENT OF *HEARING* BOARD MEMBERS.
- (5) (6) TO QUALIFY FOR APPOINTMENT AS A <u>HEARING</u> BOARD MEMBER AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE:
  - (I) OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER AND INTEGRITY:
- (II) A REGISTERED VOTER OF THE COUNTY IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE APPOINTMENT; AND
  - (III) AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE.
- (C) (D) (1) A <u>HEARING</u> BOARD MEMBER MAY NOT HOLD ANOTHER PUBLIC OFFICE OR BE EMPLOYED BY A PUBLIC BODY.
- (2) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A <u>HEARING</u> BOARD MEMBER MAY NOT HAVE A DIRECT OR INDIRECT INTEREST IN ANY PREMISES WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE MANUFACTURED OR SOLD, OR IN ANY BUSINESS WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY DEVOTED TO THE MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- (II) A <u>HEARING</u> BOARD MEMBER MAY BE A HOLDER OF A 1-DAY OR 2-DAY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.
- (3) A <u>HEARING</u> BOARD MEMBER IS REQUIRED TO BE A REGISTERED VOTER OF THE COUNTY DURING THE HEARING BOARD MEMBER'S TERM OF OFFICE.
- (4) (I) EXCEPT FOR THE TERMS OF SOME OF THE INITIAL  $\underline{HEARING}$  BOARD MEMBERS, THE TERM OF A BOARD MEMBER IS 5 YEARS.
- (II) THE TERMS OF  $\underline{HEARING}$  BOARD MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR  $\underline{HEARING}$  BOARD MEMBERS ON OCTOBER 1, 1998.
- (5) A BOARD MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY SHALL SERVE THE REMAINDER OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM.
- (6) A <u>HEARING</u> BOARD MEMBER WHOSE TERM HAS EXPIRED AND WHO HAS SERVED 8 OR MORE CONSECUTIVE YEARS ON THE <u>HEARING</u> BOARD IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR IMMEDIATE REAPPOINTMENT TO THE <u>HEARING</u> BOARD.
- (7) THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY REMOVE A <u>HEARING BOARD</u> MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE, MISCONDUCT, NEGLECT OF A DUTY REQUIRED BY LAW, UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT, DISHONORABLE CONDUCT, A VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF <u>SUBSECTION</u> (I) OF THIS SECTION <u>PARAGRAPH</u> (2)(I) OF THIS <u>SUBSECTION</u> OR FAILURE TO MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS OF SUBSECTION <del>(C)(1), (2), OR (3)</del> (C)(6)(I), (II), OR (III) OF THIS SECTION.
