

(c) (1) The notice of termination under this section shall state:

[(1)] (I) the reasons for the termination;

[(2)] (II) that the covered employee has a right to request a hearing before the Commission on the issue of the termination; and

[(3)] (III) the procedure and time for requesting a hearing.

(2) IN THE CASE OF MEDICAL BENEFITS, A COPY OF ANY MEDICAL RECORD OR REPORT RELIED UPON BY THE INSURER IN MAKING THE TERMINATION SHALL BE ATTACHED TO THE NOTICE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 812.

This bill extends the deadline for the Board of Directors of the Clipper Park Arts Center, Inc. to provide up to \$200,000 in matching funds from June 1, 1998 to June 1, 2000.

Senate Bill 681, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 14, 1998, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 812.
