(b) (2) (vi) In Caroline County, on Sunday:

1. A Class A 7-day licensee may sell the alcoholic beverages authorized under the license from 8 a.m. to 12 midnight, except that if the sale of liquor is authorized under the license, liquor may only be sold from 1:00 p.m. to 12 midnight;

2. A Class C (clubs) beer, wine and liquor licensee may sell beer and wine:

A. From 12 midnight to 2 a.m.; and

B. From 8 a.m. to 12 midnight;

3. A Class C (clubs) beer, wine and liquor licensee may sell liquor:

A. From 12 midnight to 2 a.m.; and

B. From 1 p.m. to 12 midnight; ~~and~~

4. A Class C (clubs) beer licensee may sell beer from 8 a.m. to 12 midnight; AND

5. A CLASS D (TAVERNS) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR FROM 1 P.M. TO MIDNIGHT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 857.

This bill exempts fraternal benefit societies that collected less than \$75,000 in premiums in the preceding calendar year from the insurance fraud prevention fees collected by the Maryland Insurance Administration (MIA). Currently, each society pays a \$1,000 annual fee.

Senate Bill 199, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 12, 1998, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 857.
