- (b) (1) The Governor may not reduce an appropriation to the Legislative Branch or the Judicial Branch of the State government.
 - (2) The Governor may not reduce an appropriation for:
 - (i) payment of the principal of or interest on the State debt;
- (ii) public schools, including the Maryland School for the Deaf AND THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND; or
 - (iii) the salary of a public officer, during the term of office.
- (3) Except as provided in § 8-109 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article, the Governor may not reduce an appropriation for the salary of any nontemporary employee in the State Personnel Management System.

- (h) (1) "Public body" means an entity that:
 - (i) consists of at least 2 individuals; and
 - (ii) is created by:
 - 1. the Maryland Constitution;
 - 2. a State statute;
 - a county charter;
 - 4. an ordinance;
 - 5. a rule, resolution, or bylaw;
 - 6. an executive order of the Governor; or
- 7. an executive order of the chief executive authority of a political subdivision of the State.
 - (2) "Public body" includes:
- (I) any multimember board, commission, or committee appointed by the Governor or the chief executive authority of a political subdivision of the State, if the entity includes in its membership at least 2 individuals not employed by the State or a political subdivision of the State; AND
 - (II) THE MARYLAND SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND.
 - (3) "Public body" does not include:
 - (i) any single member entity;
 - (ii) any judicial nominating commission;
