on the Board of Directors on the effective date of this Act to fill any vacancy on the Board occurring after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Department of Education shall report to the budget committees, the House Ways and Means Committee, and the Senate Finance Committee on or before September 1 of each year on the number of students enrolled in the enhanced program described in § 8–315 of the Education Article and the annual costs of the program. In addition, the Department shall report on any anticipated enrollment growth and future costs related to the enhanced program.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1267.

This bill increases the annual salary of each judge of the Orphans' Court for Cecil County from \$3,500 to \$4,500; of each judge of the Orphans' Court for Kent County from \$2,080 to \$3,600; and each judge of the Orphans' Court for Wicomico County from \$1,600 to \$3,200. The salary increases would take effect at the beginning of the next term of office which is December 1, 1998.

Senate Bill 724, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 12, 1998, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 1267.

Judges - Salary Salaries

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of a judge of the Orphans' Court for Wicomico County; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of an incumbent judge of the Orphans' Court for Wicomico County; and generally relating to the salary of judges of the Orphans' Court for Wicomico County
