

(G) AFTER RECEIVING A CERTIFICATION FROM A TAXING OFFICIAL, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL NOTIFY THE OTHER STATE IF THE COMPTROLLER DETERMINES THAT A WITHHOLDING CANNOT BE MADE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998 and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 1997.

CHAPTER 20

(Senate Bill 92)

AN ACT concerning

Annual Curative Bill

FOR the purpose of generally curing previous Acts of the General Assembly with possible title defects; providing that a professional engineer is not liable for any loss caused by an act, error, or omission of the professional engineer while practicing engineering if the act, error, or omission was not wanton, willful, intentionally tortious, or grossly negligent and the practice of engineering was performed voluntarily and without compensation, at the scene of an emergency, disaster, or catastrophic event, and at the request of a certain official acting in an official capacity under certain circumstances; requiring a court, prior to service of process of a prisoner's civil action, to review the prisoner's initial complaint and identify any cognizable claims; providing for the disposition of compensatory and punitive damages awarded to a prisoner in a certain civil action; requiring a prisoner's custodian to notify certain persons in a certain manner if the prisoner is awarded certain compensatory or punitive damages; altering the specific purposes and objectives of the School Health Program operated in Caroline County to include the provision of certain health and referral services for students; repealing a certain provision of law prohibiting fishing with a haul seine or any other net in certain waters within the limits of or adjacent or contiguous to Baltimore County without obtaining the permission of certain owners or occupiers of certain land; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to provide certain counties with certain maps; providing for the effect and construction of certain provisions of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; providing for the effective date of certain provisions of this Act; and generally repealing and reenacting without amendments certain Acts of the General Assembly that may be subject to possible title or function paragraph defects in order to validate those Acts.
