Resolution of the Council of the Town of Garrett Park adopted pursuant to Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland, Article 23A, Section 13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to amend Article II, Sections 78-5 through 78-8 of the Charter of the Town of Garrett Park so as to replace the term "councilmen" with "council members".

A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO ENHANCE FLEXIBILITY IN THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ACTING MAYOR IN THE ABSENCE OR INCAPACITATION OF THE MAYOR

Resolution of the Council of the Town of Garrett Park adopted pursuant to Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland, Article 23A, Section 13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to amend Article II, Section 78-10 of the Charter of the Town of Garrett Park so as to provide greater flexibility in the selection of an acting mayor in the absence or incapacitation of the mayor. The amendment would permit the mayor, or if the mayor fails to do so, the council, to select an acting mayor from among the council members.

A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO ENHANCE FLEXIBILITY IN THE CONDUCT OF ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS OF THE TOWN

Resolution of the Council of the Town of Garrett Park adopted pursuant to Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland, Article 23A, Section 13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to amend Article II, Section 78-16(d) of the Charter of the Town of Garrett Park so as to provide the mayor with additional options in the conduct of the administrative matters of the town, if the mayor so chooses. This amendment would permit the mayor to delegate administrative responsibilities to council members.
