

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

with amendments, Subsection E(1), of Section 267-53, Specific Standards; of Article VIII, Special Exceptions, all of Part 1, Standards, of Chapter 267, Zoning; to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Tables XIII and XIV, Design Requirements for Specific Uses, all of the Harford County Code, as amended to define a certain term; to establish certain requirements for mineral extraction and processing use; to make this an Emergency Act; and generally relating to mineral extraction and processing.

HOWARD COUNTY

Bill No. 4-1997

AN ACT permitting certain owners of certain privately owned lots located in pre-1961 platted subdivisions that do not have roads and stormwater management facilities to request that the County construct and acquire these improvements; establishing procedures to provide for an informational meeting to review the request; authorizing the Director of Public Works to define one or more capital projects for purposes of design and construction of improvements; authorizing the County to design and construct improvements after certain conditions are satisfied; requiring that certain agreements exist for the reimbursement to the County for the costs of improvements and for the acquisition by the county of property interests in the improvements; and establishing a road and stormwater management facilities improvement financing program.

Bill No. 5-1997

AN ACT pursuant to Section 1.606(e) of the Howard County Code approving provisions in the collective bargaining agreement between Howard County and Local 86 of the International Union of Police Associations that are in conflict with the provisions of Title 1 "Personnel Administration" of the Howard County Code; approving changes to the collective bargaining agreement contingent upon the taking effect of certain changes to the Police and Fire Employees Retirement Plan; and making the provisions of this Act retroactive to July 1, 1996.
