

MONTGOMERY COUNTY

(11) increase the number of residents who can reside in a group home from 14 to 16, or the maximum number allowed under a state license, whichever is less;

(12) exempt from licensure group homes which provide no more than 50 hours of supervision a week, and clarify that unrelated persons living together as a housekeeping unit may procure supporting care services without being licensed as a group home;

(13) add certain domiciliary care homes to the definition of a group home; and

(14) make conforming, technical, and stylistic changes in the group home law.
