- (1) create an [[Auditor]] <u>Inspector</u> General and assign the [[Auditor]] <u>Inspector</u> General certain powers and duties;

- (3) require departments of County government and certain independent County agencies to submit certain information to the [[Auditor]] Inspector General;
- (4) direct the [[Auditor]] $\underline{\underline{Inspector}}$ General to submit certain workplans and reports;
- (5) terminate the position and Office of the [[Auditor]] $\underline{\underline{Inspector}}$ General on a certain date; and
