

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

Bill No. 18-97

Chapter 30

Laws of Montgomery County, 1997

AN ACT to:

(1) require that an alarm system must be inspected by a licensed alarm business;

(2) require [[the County Executive or designee]] regulations to establish a time period for [[the submission of]] the inspection [[certificates]] of an alarm system;

(3) authorize the [[County Executive or designee]] enforcing agency to waive an inspection or upgrade requirement [[for good cause]] if the agency determines that a sufficient number of false alarms in a calendar year could not have been related to a defect or malfunction; and

(4) change the date on which the County Executive must provide a report to the Council
