

(d) A license may be issued on behalf of an organization that owns or manages a golf course with a minimum of 18 holes.

(e) The annual license fee is \$1,500.

(f) The license is for the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises.

(g) The hours and days for sale are found in § 11-514 of this article. However, the Board may reduce the hours and days for sale for all or a portion of the licensed premises.

(h) The Board may place conditions on the location of sales and consumption, including:

(1) Prohibiting the sale and consumption of liquor on specified areas of the licensed premises; and

(2) Permitting the sale and consumption of only beer and light wine on specified areas of the licensed premises.

(i) The Board may restrict the sale of alcoholic beverages to beer and light wine if the Board determines that circumstances warrant.

8-505.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) "Board" means the Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners.

(3) "Commission" means the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

(b) (1) The Board may issue special 7-day Class B-GC (golf course) on-sale beer and wine licenses for the exclusive use on the premises of the Commission's golf courses located within Prince George's County.

(2) The special 7-day Class B-GC on-sale beer and wine license authorizes the holder to sell beer and wine from 1 or more outlets for consumption on the premises of the golf course.

(3) (i) A separate license is required for each applicable golf course.

(ii) A special 7-day Class B-GC on-sale beer and wine license shall be issued to each of the managers of the Commission's golf courses upon making application and qualifying as a license holder under this article.

(4) (i) Except as provided in this subsection, the hours of sale for beer and wine under this license are from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily, Monday through Sunday.
