- (IV) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION;
- (V) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION;
- (VI) TWO SHALL BE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LAYPERSONS TO THE FIELD OF MEDICINE, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE AN ORGAN OR TISSUE TRANSPLANT RECIPIENT:
- (VII) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION;
- (VIII) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MEDICAL AND CHIRURGICAL FACULTY OF MARYLAND;
- (IX) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND NURSES ASSOCIATION;
- (X) ONE SHALL BE A FAMILY MEMBER OF AN ORGAN OR TISSUE DONOR;
  - (XI) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND; AND
  - (XII) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES.
  - (B) (1) THE TERM OF A VOTING MEMBER IS 4 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON JULY 1, 1998.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (C) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.

FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN FOR A 2-YEAR TERM.

- (A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS THEN SERVING ON THE ADVISORY COUNCIL IS A QUORUM.
- (B) THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.
  - (C) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL:
