All male prisoners confined in an institution or facility under the jurisdiction of the Division of Correction, or any of the county, town or city jails, shall be liable to labor upon the State, county and city roads and streets in accordance with the provisions of [§§ 719] THIS SECTION AND §§ 720 to 726 OF THIS ARTICLE; provided that nothing in said sections shall apply to the Baltimore City jail, or to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, or to the public highways of the City.

(j) (1) The chief, or hearing board, as the case may be, shall in connection with any disciplinary hearing have the power to administer oaths and to issue summonses to compel the attendance and testimony of witnesses, and the production of books, papers, records, and documents as may be relevant or necessary. These summonses may be served in accordance with the Maryland Rules [of Procedure] pertaining to service of process issued by a court, without cost. Any party may request the chief or hearing board to issue a summons or order under the provisions of this subtitle.
