- (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, this subtitle applies only to:
- (1) an employee of the Department of Natural Resources commissioned by the Secretary of Natural Resources as:
 - (i) a Natural Resources police officer; or
- (ii) a law enforcement officer, other than a Natural Resources police officer;
- (2) a law enforcement officer employed by the Maryland Investigative Services Unit;
- (3) a member of the Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force who has the powers granted to a police officer under § 4-208 of the Transportation Article; or
- $\mbox{\em (4)}$ a deputy sheriff employed by the Baltimore City Sheriff's Department.

- (b) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, membership in the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System is optional for an individual described in § 26-201 of this subtitle:
- (i) who was employed by the Department of Natural Resources on July 1, 1990 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 1997;
- (ii) who was employed by the Maryland Investigative Services Unit on June 30, 1995 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 1997;
- (iii) who was employed by the Maryland Transportation Authority on June 30, 1997 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 1997; or
- (iv) who was employed by the Baltimore City Sheriff's Department on June 30, 1997 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 1997.
