2000. The first two installments of the proceeds of the loan shall be equal to the lesser of \$125,000 or the amount of the installment of the matching fund provided by the grantee at that time. The third installment of the proceeds of the loan shall be equal to the amount of the third installment of the matching fund, except that the total amount of the proceeds of the loan may not exceed [\$375,000] \$300,000.

## Chapter 254 of the Acts of 1997

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (c) The Task Force shall be composed of [12] 14 members as follows:
- (1) One member of the House of Delegates of Maryland, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and who shall be co-chairman of the Task Force;
- (2) One member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate, who shall be co-chairman of the Task Force; and
  - (3) The following members appointed by the Governor:
- (i) A representative of the Department of Budget and Management;
  - (ii) A representative of the State Department of Education;
- (iii) A representative of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
  - (iv) A representative of the Department of Human Resources;
  - (v) · A representative of a local education agency;
  - (vi) A member of the Governor's Advisory Board on Homelessness;
  - (vii) A member of the Maryland Association of Boards of Education;
- (viii) A member of the Public School Superintendents' Association of Maryland;
- $% \left( ix\right) =\left( ix\right) -A$  member of the Maryland Association of Pupil Transportation Supervisors;
- (x) Two members of the general public who are providers to and advocates for homeless persons, including shelter providers and representatives of legal advocacy groups; and
