AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that the [change to] ENACTMENT OF § 14-404(a)(38) of the Health Occupations Article [made] by this Act may not impair a licensed physician from legitimately preparing for an action before the State Board of Physician Quality Assurance.
