

Article 12 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1985 Edition and December 1997 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 12 - Garrett County

20-6.

[A. Industrial Engineer. The County Commissioners of Garrett County are hereby authorized to employ an Industrial Engineer, whose annual salary and expenses shall not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.). The Industrial Engineer shall be a person with wide and varied experience in the field of industry and allied economic endeavors. It shall be the duty of the Industrial Engineer to publicize the merits of Garrett County for all types of industry and to aid industry in locating in Garrett County. It shall also be the duty of the Industrial Engineer to assist those industries presently located in Garrett County and to administer an overall program of economic development for Garrett County. The County Commissioners, in their discretion, may engage the services of a company or agency to locate sites for industrial expansion and for industries seeking locations.

B. Committee on Economic Development.] The County Commissioners shall [also] appoint a Committee on Economic Development, to be composed of [five (5)] 5 members, who shall represent the geographical areas of Garrett County. The members of the Committee shall serve without compensation and at the pleasure of the County Commissioners. It shall be the duty of the Committee on Economic Development [to assist the Industrial Engineer in an advisory capacity and] to assist in the development of an overall program of economic development for Garrett County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.
