- (1) All money for the construction of public school buildings and public school facilities and the purchase of land for public schools in a separate account from that used for current expenses; and
- (2) A separate and independent accounting system for all public school construction money.
- (b) (1) In Anne Arundel County, the County Board may borrow from one fund to meet temporary cash requirements of another fund or to reimburse another fund for services performed.
- (2) This borrowing or reimbursement is subject to the county charter. 5-305.1.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BOARD MAY INCLUDE CAPITAL PROJECTS THAT ARE TO BE FUNDED OVER A PERIOD OF 2 FISCAL YEARS IN THE CAPITAL BUDGET, WHETHER OR NOT PART OF THE FUNDING PERIOD FALLS IN A CALENDAR YEAR THAT IS AN ELECTION YEAR FOR COUNTY OFFICIALS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 37

(House Bill 65)

AN ACT concerning

Soil Conservation Districts - Funding

FOR the purpose of altering the mechanism for funding certain activities of certain soil conservation districts through fee systems; requiring certain soil conservation districts to develop certain costs in the preparation of certain fee systems; requiring submission of certain fee systems to certain local governing bodies; allowing certain local governing bodies to provide certain funding to soil conservation districts in certain manners; providing that certain fee systems shall take effect in a certain manner under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to soil conservation districts and funding.
