

(2) The proximity of the proposed center to any existing senior citizen activities center; and

(3) Localities eligible for State funding that have not received previous funding under this or similar acts.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

**CHAPTER 42**

**(House Bill 104)**

AN ACT concerning

**Howard County - Board of Education - Compensation**

**Ho. Co. 12-98**

FOR the purpose of increasing the annual compensation of the Chairman and the other members of the Howard County Board of Education.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education

Section 3-703

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1997 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

3-703.

(a) The Chairman of the County Board is entitled to receive ~~[\$10,000]~~ \$11,000 annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive ~~[\$9,000]~~ \$9,900 each annually as compensation.

(b) The Chairman and the other members are entitled to the allowances for travel and other expenses provided in the Howard County budget.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.
