- 1. Endorsed with the certificate of the collector of taxes of the county in which the property is assessed, required under subsection (b) of this section; and
 - 2. Accompanied by:
 - A. A complete intake sheet; and
- B. A copy of the instrument, and any survey, for submission to the Department of Assessments and Taxation.
- (iii) The Supervisor of Assessments shall transfer ownership of property in the assessment records, effective as of the date of recordation, upon receipt from the Clerk of the Circuit Court of a copy of the instrument, the completed intake sheet, and any survey submitted under subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County, the Administrative Office of the Courts, the State Department of Assessments and Taxation, and the collector of taxes for Howard County may formulate the procedures governing recordation of instruments as authorized under this Act, so as to simplify the procedures for recordation of instruments while insuring ensuring the integrity of the land and assessment records.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 46

(House Bill 129)

AN ACT concerning

Emergency Medical Services Providers

FOR the purpose of clarifying that certain definitions of "health care provider", "health care practitioner", and "health practitioner" in the Code include certain emergency medical services personnel; making technical corrections to certain provisions of the Code pertaining to emergency medical services; establishing certain penalties; defining certain terms; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to emergency medical services.
