SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

(a) (5) "Health care provider" means any person who is authorized to practice under the Health Occupations Article OR § 13-516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

(h) (1) "Health practitioner" includes any person who is authorized to practice healing under the Health Occupations Article OR § 13-516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.

(2) "HEALTH PRACTITIONER" DOES NOT INCLUDE AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL DISPATCHER.

(h) (1) "Health care provider" means:

(i) A person who is licensed, certified, or otherwise authorized under the Health Occupations Article OR § 13-516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE to provide health care in the ordinary course of business or practice of a profession or in an approved education or training program; or
