(House Bill 131)

AN ACT concerning

Mental Hygiene Administration - Facilities

FOR the purpose of removing the Highland Health Facility at the Baltimore City Hospitals from the list of inpatient facilities operated by the Mental Hygiene Administration; simplifying the name of the Walter P. Carter Center and clarifying the name of the Regional Institutes for Children; and generally relating to the inpatient facilities operated by the Mental Hygiene Administration.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

10-406.

- (a) The following State facilities shall be maintained under the direction of the Administration:
 - (1) Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center.
 - (2) Crownsville Hospital Center.
 - (3) Eastern Shore Hospital Center.
- (4) Regional Institutes for Children and Adolescents Baltimore [and Montgomery Counties.], ROCKVILLE, AND SOUTHERN MARYLAND.
 - (5) Springfield Hospital Center.
 - (6) Spring Grove Hospital Center.
- (7) Walter P. Carter [Community Mental Health and Retardation] Center [at the University of Maryland Hospital].
- (8) [The part of the Highland Health Facility at the Baltimore City Hospitals that the Administration operates.
