(b) (1) Subject to paragraph (4) of this subsection, the Board shall establish reasonable fees for EXAMINATIONS, reinstatements, certifications, applications, reopening inspections, per diem fees for Board members, compensation for inspectors appointed by the Board, and for any other service performed by the Board necessary to carry out the provisions of this title.

(2) [The] EXCEPT FOR THE EXAMINATION FEES WHICH THE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH IN AMOUNTS NOT TO EXCEED THE COSTS OF THE EXAMINATIONS, THE fees established by the Board shall be set in a manner that will produce funds sufficient to cover the actual direct and indirect costs of regulating the cosmetology industry in the State in accordance with the provisions of this title.

(3) The total cost of regulating the cosmetology industry in the State in accordance with the provisions of this title may not be more than the revenues generated by the fees established under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

(4) The Board shall require a \$25 fee for the licensure or renewal of licensure of cosmetologists, senior cosmetologists, estheticians, manicurists, and makeup artists.

(a) An applicant for a license:

(1) shall submit to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; and

(2) except as provided in § 5-308 of this subtitle, shall pay to the Board OR THE BOARD'S DESIGNEE the appropriate [application] EXAMINATION fee established by the Board in accordance with § 5-205 of this title IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE COST OF THE REQUIRED EXAMINATION.

(b) In addition to the other requirements of this section, an applicant for a license to provide makeup artist services shall submit to the Board credentials that certify sufficient training.

(a) [An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN § 5-307.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN APPLICANT is entitled to be examined as provided in this section IF THE APPLICANT:

(1) OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS TITLE; AND

(2) PAYS AN EXAMINATION FEE, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH ~~§ 5-205~~ §§ 5-205 AND 5-306 OF THIS TITLE, TO THE BOARD OR THE BOARD'S DESIGNEE.
