

(e) If an individual passes a fundamentals of engineering examination under this section and pays the Board a certification fee of \$15, the Board shall:

(1) keep a record that the individual passed the examination; and

(2) issue to the individual a certificate that states that the individual is an engineer-in-training because the individual has passed the examination and that sets forth:

(i) the full name of the individual;

(ii) a certificate number assigned by the Board to the individual;
and

(iii) the signatures of the chairman and secretary of the Board, under seal of the Board.

(f) If an individual takes and fails a fundamentals of engineering examination under this section, the individual shall have the same rights regarding notice, review procedures, and reexamination provided to an applicant under §§ 14-308 and 14-309 of this subtitle.

(a) An applicant for a license shall:

(1) submit to the Board:

(i) an application on the form that the Board provides; and

(ii) any relevant document that the Board requires; and

(2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN § 15-311(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE, pay to the Board OR THE BOARD'S DESIGNEE an [application] EXAMINATION fee [set by the Board [not to exceed the cost of administering] IN AN AMOUNT COVERING NOT TO EXCEED THE COST OF the required examination [to the applicant].

(b) (1) The application form shall require:

(i) a statement about the education of the applicant;

(ii) a statement about the experience of the applicant in land or property line surveying;

(iii) a list of at least 5 references that, unless excused by the Board, shall include:

1. for a land surveyor applicant, at least 3 professional land surveyors who have personal knowledge of the applicant's land surveying experience; and

2. for a property line surveyor applicant, at least 3 individuals, each of whom:
