

(2) THE CHAIRMAN SHALL DESIGNATE AT LEAST ONE MEETING EACH YEAR AS AN EXECUTIVE MEETING.

(3) A COMMITTEE MEMBER MAY SEND A DESIGNEE TO REPRESENT THE MEMBER AT ANY MEETING THAT IS NOT AN EXECUTIVE MEETING.

(D) In the event the members of the Interagency Committee should fail to agree on a plan for services to elderly persons, the chairman of the Committee shall refer the matter to the Governor for resolution.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
