AN ACT concerning

Education - Institutional Educator Pay Plan

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Budget and Management to establish and administer an Institutional Educator Pay Plan; requiring the Secretary of Budget and Management to conduct certain reviews and make salary recommendations by a certain date; establishing an Institutional Educator Pay Plan Advisory Committee; requiring the Committee to review and comment on certain recommendations; and generally relating to salaries of individuals employed in institutions as educators.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

6-302.

- (a) An individual who is employed as a teacher, librarian, principal, director of education, or supervisor of vocational education on the staffs of the following institutions or in the following programs, or an individual who is employed as a central office director, superintendent, specialist, or coordinator of education for the following institutions or programs, shall be paid the annual salary determined under subsection (b) of this section:
 - (1) Any institution that is under the jurisdiction of:
 - (i) The Department of Juvenile Justice; or
 - (ii) The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- (2) Any vocational rehabilitation program operated by the State Department of Education; and
- (3) Any correctional education program operated by the State Department of Education in a facility of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services.
- (b) (1) There shall be a single, statewide institutional educator pay plan for the positions described under subsection (a) of this section. The pay plan shall be
