- (i) [4] 5 who shall represent the aquaculture OR AGRICULTURE industry;
- $\mbox{(ii)} \mbox{ 1 who shall represent [seafood packers] THE AQUACULTURE SUPPLIER INDUSTRY;}$
 - (iii) 1 who shall represent licensed Maryland seafood harvesters;
- (iv) [1] 2 who shall represent the wholesale and retail seafood industry;
 - (v) [1 who shall represent the agricultural industry;
 - (vi)] 1 who shall represent seafood consumers;
 - [(vii)] (VI) 1 who shall represent the scientific community; AND
 - [(viii) 1 member of the Tidal Fisheries Advisory Commission; and
- (ix)] (VII) 1 member of the Boat Act Advisory Commission OR THE TIDAL FISHERIES ADVISORY COMMISSION.
- (c) The Advisory Committee shall formulate and make proposals for advancing Maryland aquaculture, including recommendations for a fee structure on aquaculture operations in order to reduce State expenditures on aquaculture programs.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 81

(House Bill 580)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Nursing - Discipline

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Nursing to require certain licensees to undergo a certain examination by a health care provider under certain circumstances; requiring that certain licensees are deemed to have consented to certain examinations and to have waived claims of privilege regarding the resulting examination reports or testimony; requiring the Board to pay the costs of an examination; specifying certain circumstances under which a licensee may be placed on probation or have a license suspended, denied, or revoked; establishing a penalty for certain licensed nurses who disobey subpoenas from the Board; and generally relating to discipline taken against certain licensed nurses.
