

(III) MAXIMUM VARIATION FROM A ZONING REQUIREMENT ALLOWABLE UNDER AN ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUSTMENT.

(6) PROCEDURES FOR ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUSTMENTS MAY INCLUDE:

- (I) APPLICATIONS;
- (II) NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC AND PARTIES IN INTEREST;
- (III) OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC HEARING;
- (IV) TAKING OF TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE; AND
- (V) DECISION MAKING.

(7) A DECISION ON AN APPLICATION FOR AN ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUSTMENT SHALL INCLUDE WRITTEN FINDINGS OF FACT.

(8) THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY MAY PROVIDE, BY ORDINANCE OR OTHER ADOPTED PROCEDURE, FOR THE APPEAL OF A DECISION TO APPROVE OR DENY AN ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUSTMENT TO THE BOARD OF APPEALS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

(House Bill 717)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - County Treasurer - Orders to Pay Out Moneys

FOR the purpose of requiring orders to the County Treasurer of Charles County to pay out moneys to be presented to the Treasurer in accordance with a certain process established by the County Commissioners of Charles County; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to orders to pay out moneys to the County Treasurer of Charles County.

Article 9 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
