- (II) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE BOARD OF ELECTION SUPERVISORS MAY AUTHORIZE AN ELECTION JUDGE, OTHER THAN A CHIEF JUDGE, TO SERVE FOR LESS THAN A FULL DAY.
- (2) A judge who is appointed to serve in a district, ward, or precinct other than the one in which he is registered to vote and who chooses to vote shall east his vote by absentee ballot pursuant to § 27 1(a).
- (e) Blank forms for the appointment of the substitute judges and the eath aforesaid shall be supplied by the board, and the eath when administered shall be preserved and returned by the judges to the board.
- (d) The appointment and swearing in of all such substitutes and the reason therefor and the time when such substitute began and ceased to serve shall be noted by the judges on loose leaf pages inserted in the binders containing the precinct cards; such substitute shall cease to act whenever the judge in whose stead he was appointed shall be present.

(d) A local board may adopt guidelines consistent with the provisions of this title for the determination of the qualifications of persons considered for appointment and for the process of appointment as election judges. TO THE EXTENT NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SUBTITLE, THE GUIDELINES MAY PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ELECTION JUDGE, OTHER THAN THE CHIEF JUDGE, TO SERVE FOR LESS THAN A FULL DAY AND FOR THE JUDGE TO BE COMPENSATED, ON A PRORATA BASIS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEES SET UNDER § 10–205 OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR A JUDGE SERVING A FULL DAY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1999.

CHAPTER 100

(House Bill 1081)

. AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County Cultural Center Loan of 1994

FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 321 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994, the Montgomery County Cultural Center Loan of 1994, to allow the proceeds of the bonds and the matching fund to be used for the planning, design, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of a building in Silver Spring, the building to be used as a theater and as a facility for activities associated with the theater, and to extend the time by which the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund to June 1, 2000.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
