

CHAPTER 106
(House Bill 1301)

AN ACT concerning

Local Emergency Preparedness Plans

FOR the purpose of requiring each county and Baltimore City to prepare a certain Emergency Preparedness Plan for responding to emergencies that involve certain hazardous materials or controlled hazardous substances and to submit the Plan to the Director of the Maryland Emergency Management Agency by a certain date; requiring each county and Baltimore City to review a certain Emergency Preparedness Plan and to submit any changes to the Plan to the Director of the Maryland Emergency Management Agency for a certain purpose; and generally relating to certain local emergency preparedness plans.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 18-204(a) and (b), respectively, of Article 41 – Governor – Executive and Administrative Departments of the Annotated Code of Maryland be transferred to be Section(s) 4(d)(1) and (2), respectively, of Article 16A – Maryland Emergency Management Agency of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
