

"STEAM HEATING COMPANY" MEANS A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY THAT MANUFACTURES, SELLS, OR DISTRIBUTES STEAM FOR USE, SALE, OR DISTRIBUTION.

(X) STREET RAILROAD.

"STREET RAILROAD" MEANS A RAILROAD:

(1) THAT IS NOT PART OF A TRUNK LINE RAILWAY SYSTEM; AND

(2) WHOSE ROUTES ARE MAINLY WITHIN BALTIMORE CITY OR A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WITH A POPULATION OF AT LEAST 2,000.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 78, § 2(u).

In this subsection, the former reference to the "corporate limits" is deleted as redundant in light of the reference to routes "within" Baltimore City or a municipal corporation.

Also in this subsection, the former reference to "people" is deleted as redundant in light of the use of the term "population".

Defined term: "Railroad" § 1-101

(Y) TAXICAB.

(1) "TAXICAB" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR HIRE THAT:

(I) IS DESIGNED TO CARRY SEVEN OR FEWER INDIVIDUALS, INCLUDING THE DRIVER; AND

(II) IS USED TO ACCEPT OR SOLICIT PASSENGERS FOR TRANSPORTATION BETWEEN POINTS ALONG PUBLIC STREETS AS THE PASSENGERS REQUEST.

(2) "TAXICAB" DOES NOT INCLUDE A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATED ON A REGULAR SCHEDULE AND BETWEEN FIXED POINTS WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSION AS DEFINED IN TITLE 11 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 78, § 2(v).

In paragraph (1)(ii) of this subsection, the former references to transportation "for hire" and between "those" points are deleted as unnecessary.

Also in paragraph (1)(ii) of this subsection, the word "passengers" is substituted for the former reference to "members of the public" for clarity.
