(CC) TELEPHONE LINES.

"TELEPHONE LINES" MEANS THE MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT, AND PROPERTY OWNED BY A TELEPHONE COMPANY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 78, § 2(z).

In this subsection, the reference to "the material, equipment, and property" of a telephone company is substituted for the former references to the "plant" and the "appliances, buildings, crossbars, easements, instruments, machines, poles, real estate, receivers, transmitters and wires" for brevity, accuracy, and consistency within this title.

(DD) TOLL BRIDGE.

"TOLL BRIDGE" MEANS A BRIDGE OPERATED BY A PERSON AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION TO CHARGE AND COLLECT TOLL FROM TRAFFIC USING THE BRIDGE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 78, § 2(aa).

In this subsection, the reference to the granting of authority "by the Commission" to charge and collect a toll is added for clarity.

(EE) TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS FOR HIRE.

(1) "TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS FOR HIRE" MEANS THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS BY:

- (I) REGULARLY SCHEDULED OPERATIONS;
- (II) CHARTER OR CONTRACT OPERATIONS; OR
- (III) TOUR OR SIGHTSEEING OPERATIONS.

(2) "TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS FOR HIRE" INCLUDES THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS, WHETHER ON THE COOPERATIVE PLAN, CARRIED BY A CORPORATION, GROUP, OR ASSOCIATION ENGAGED IN THE TRANSPORTATION OF ITS STOCKHOLDERS, SHAREHOLDERS, OR MEMBERS.

The word "persons", in the defined term, is substituted for the former reference to "passengers" for clarity.
