2-105. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

(A) APPOINTMENT.

THE COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT AN EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

(B) TERM.

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSION.

(C) DUTIES.

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL:

- (1) DIRECT AND COORDINATE THE TECHNICAL STAFF, EXCEPT HEARING EXAMINERS, OF THE COMMISSION; AND
 - (2) PERFORM THE OTHER DUTIES THAT THE COMMISSION PRESCRIBES.

2-106. GENERAL COUNSEL.

(A) APPOINTMENT.

THE COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT A GENERAL COUNSEL.

(B) QUALIFICATION.

THE GENERAL COUNSEL SHALL HAVE BEEN ADMITTED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE STATE.

(C) OATH.

BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, THE GENERAL COUNSEL SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.

(D) TERM.

THE GENERAL COUNSEL SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE COMMISSION.
