

2-109. RECORDS.

(A) COPIES OF DOCUMENTS.

(1) ON REQUEST OF THE COMMISSION, A PUBLIC OFFICER SHALL GIVE TO THE COMMISSION, WITHOUT CHARGE, A CERTIFIED COPY OF A DOCUMENT OR PART OF A DOCUMENT ON FILE WITH THE OFFICER.

(2) WITHOUT CHARGE, A PUBLIC OFFICER SHALL ACCEPT FROM THE COMMISSION ANY DOCUMENT AUTHORIZED OR REQUIRED TO BE FILED WITH THE OFFICER AND SHALL ENTER, FILE, DOCKET, OR RECORD THE DOCUMENT.

(B) PUBLIC RECORDS.

EACH RECORD OF THE COMMISSION IS A PUBLIC RECORD AND SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC AT REASONABLE TIMES.

2-110. COMMISSION EXPENSES.

(A) PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.

(1) (I) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COSTS AND EXPENSES OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE BORNE BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE COMMISSION'S JURISDICTION.

(II) THE COSTS AND EXPENSES SHALL BE ASSESSED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(2) AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE COSTS AND EXPENSES OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE STATE BUDGET AND PAID FROM THE STATE TREASURY.

(3) THE STATE TREASURY SHALL BE REIMBURSED FROM THE MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

(B) COMMISSION COSTS REIMBURSED.

(1) (I) BEFORE EACH STATE FISCAL YEAR, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION SHALL ESTIMATE THE COMMISSION'S TOTAL COSTS AND EXPENSES, INCLUDING:

1. THE COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF THE COMMISSION, ITS OFFICERS, AGENTS, AND PERSONNEL;
