SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

11–105.

(o) (1) THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE AN APPLICATION FEE FROM
AN INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION SEEKING CERTIFICATION TO
OPERATE IN THE STATE.

(2) Subject to the provisions of § 11–203 of this title, the Commission
may require bonds or other financial guaranties from institutions of postsecondary
education seeking certification or recertification to operate in the State.

11–202.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an institution of
postsecondary education may not commence or continue to operate, do business, or
function without a certificate of approval from the Commission.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2008.
