(B) ANIMAL WASTE TECHNOLOGY PROJECT.

"ANIMAL WASTE TECHNOLOGY PROJECT" MEANS A PROJECT THAT INVOLVES THE RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, IMPLEMENTATION, OR MARKET DEVELOPMENT OF TECHNOLOGY THAT IS INTENDED TO:

- (1) REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF NUTRIENTS IN ANIMAL WASTE;
- (2) ALTER THE COMPOSITION OF ANIMAL WASTE;
- (3) DEVELOP ALTERNATIVE ANIMAL WASTE MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES; OR
- (4) USE ANIMAL WASTE IN A PRODUCTION PROCESS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 83A, § 5-1401(b).

In the introductory language of this subsection, the reference to "a project that involves" the research, development, implementation, or market development of technology is added for conformity with subsections (c) and (f) of this section.

In item (3) of this subsection, the reference to "animal" waste is added for consistency within this subsection.

(C) AQUACULTURE PROJECT.

"AQUACULTURE PROJECT" MEANS A PROJECT THAT ENCOURAGES INNOVATION, EXPANSION, AND MODERNIZATION OF THE SEAFOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRY OR AQUACULTURE INDUSTRY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly was Art. 83A, § 5-1401(c).

The only change is in style.

(D) ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT.

"ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT" MEANS AN AREA DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY AS AN ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT UNDER TITLE 4, SUBTITLE 7 OF THIS ARTICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 83A, § 5-1401(d).

The reference to "the Secretary" is added to clarify that the Secretary is the authority that designates arts and entertainment districts.
