SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as otherwise provided by law, all existing laws, rules and regulations, proposed rules and regulations, standards and guidelines, policies, orders and other directives, forms, plans, memberships, contracts, property, investigations, administrative and judicial responsibilities, rights to sue and be sued, and all other duties and responsibilities associated with the functions of the Department of Budget and Management's Office of Information Technology prior to the effective date of this Act shall continue in effect under the Department of Information Technology until completed, withdrawn, canceled, modified, or otherwise changed pursuant to law.

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

## CHAPTER 10

(Senate Bill 46)

AN ACT concerning

FOR the purpose of altering the distribution of the sales and use tax revenue; altering the State income tax rate for certain income of individuals for certain taxable years; altering the definition of "taxable service" under the sales and use tax to repeal the tax on certain computer services; providing certain sales and use tax exemptions relating to certain computer services and certain computer software maintenance contracts; repealing a certain termination date; repealing a certain definition; making a technical correction; requiring the Comptroller to waive certain interest and penalties for a certain taxable year to a certain extent; stating the intent of the General Assembly that the Governor present to the Board of Public Works a certain schedule for reductions to certain expenditures from the State budget for a certain fiscal year; providing for the application of
