2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Economic Matters Committee; and

(ii) On or before [June 30] DECEMBER 31, 2008, submit a final report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year and 1 month] 2 YEARS and, at the end of [July 31, 2008] JUNE 30, 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 12

(House Bill 17)

AN ACT concerning

Task Force to Study the Boating Industry in Maryland
