(ii) when a petition for guardianship or adoption is filed or consent to guardianship or adoption is given, is a minor.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 14

(Senate Bill 28)

AN ACT concerning

All-Terrain Vehicles - Protective Headgear Vehicle Safety Task Force

FOR the purpose of prohibiting an individual under a certain age from operating or riding on an all-terrain vehicle unless the individual is wearing protective headgear that meets certain standards; defining a certain term; and generally relating to required equipment for individuals operating or riding on all-terrain vehicles establishing an All-Terrain Vehicle Safety Task Force; providing for the membership and duties of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to select a chair from among its members; providing for the staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation; requiring the Task Force to report to the Governor and the General Assembly by certain dates; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the establishment of an All-Terrain Vehicle Safety Task Force.
