(Senate Bill 28)

AN ACT concerning

### All-Terrain Vehicles—Protective Headgear Vehicle Safety Task Force

FOR the purpose of ~~prohibiting an individual under a certain age from operating or riding on an all terrain vehicle unless the individual is wearing protective headgear that meets certain standards; defining a certain term; and generally relating to required equipment for individuals operating or riding on all terrain vehicles~~ establishing an All-Terrain Vehicle Safety Task Force; providing for the membership and duties of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to select a chair from among its members; providing for the staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation; requiring the Task Force to report to the Governor and the General Assembly by certain dates; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the establishment of an All-Terrain Vehicle Safety Task Force.
