SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Education**

7–303.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) “Criminal gang” has the meaning stated in § 9–801 of the Criminal Law Article.

(3) “Law enforcement agency” means the law enforcement agencies listed in § 3–101(e) of the Public Safety Article.

(4) “Local school system” means the schools and school programs under the supervision of the local superintendent.

~~(I)~~ (I) THE county superintendent, for the county in which a [child] STUDENT is enrolled, or a designee of the superintendent, who is an administrator; OR

(II) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS FOR THE:

1. ARCHDIOCESE OF BALTIMORE;
2. ARCHDIOCESE OF WASHINGTON; AND
3. CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF WILMINGTON.
