

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

AN ACT concerning

Task Force on Educational Issues Affecting Military Children

FOR the purpose of establishing, through a certain Interstate Compact with certain other member states, the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children for certain purposes; providing for the transfer of certain educational records and enrollment of certain children in certain schools; providing for the placement of certain children in certain courses, educational programs, and special education services on transfer; establishing certain eligibility criteria for certain school programs; establishing certain procedures to facilitate the graduation of certain students from high school; establishing a certain State Council for coordinating certain services; establishing the Interstate Commission on Educational Opportunity for Military Children; providing for the composition, meetings, and powers and duties of the Interstate Commission; providing for the organization and operation and the rulemaking functions of the Interstate Commission; providing for the oversight and enforcement of the Interstate Compact and the resolution of disputes between certain member states; providing for the financing of the Interstate Commission; establishing procedures for amending the Interstate Compact; establishing certain withdrawal and dissolution procedures for certain members of the Interstate Compact; defining certain terms; making this Act subject to a certain contingency; and generally relating to the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children a Task Force on Educational Issues Affecting Military Children; establishing the membership and staffing of the Task Force; providing for the designation of the chair of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to evaluate and make recommendations regarding certain issues; requiring the Task Force to submit a certain report to the
