

(h) The Task Force shall continue to advise the Governor and the General Assembly on the implementation of its recommendations until this Act is abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of July 31, 2009, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 413

(Senate Bill 514)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Law Examiners – Sunset Extension and Program Evaluation

FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Law Examiners in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; requiring that an evaluation of the Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board be performed on or before a certain date; increasing the maximum Bar examination fee that the Court of Appeals may impose on an applicant; ~~requiring the Court of Appeals to implement the initial increase of certain fees in a certain manner; requiring the Court of Appeals to report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date;~~ stating the intent of the General Assembly concerning certain fee revenue and certain expenditures; and generally relating to the State Board of Law Examiners.
