SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

10-208.

(a) An applicant for admission to the Bar shall submit to the Board a petition to the Court of Appeals on the form that the Board provides.

(b) An applicant shall pay to the Board:

(1) an examination fee ~~not exceeding \$150~~ **\$400**, as set by the Court of Appeals, **NOT EXCEEDING:**

(I) \$250 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009; AND

(II) \$400 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 AND THEREAFTER; and

(2) any other fee set by the Court of Appeals.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this subtitle shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2010] **2020**.

Article - State Government

8-403.

(a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this section.
